

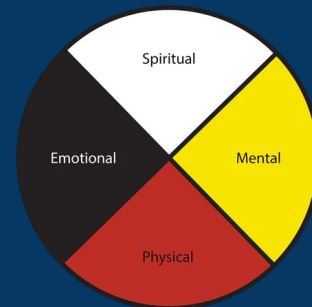

I refuse to participate in the problem.


We are all different, but we all deserve respect.

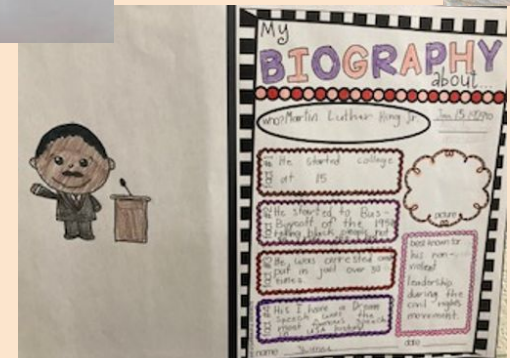
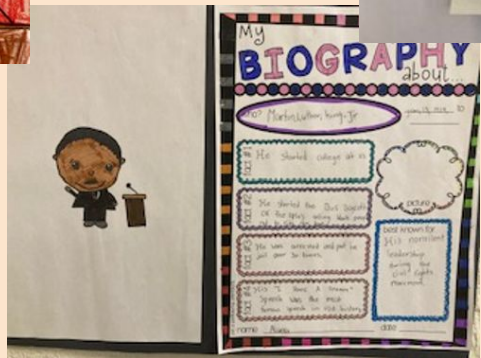
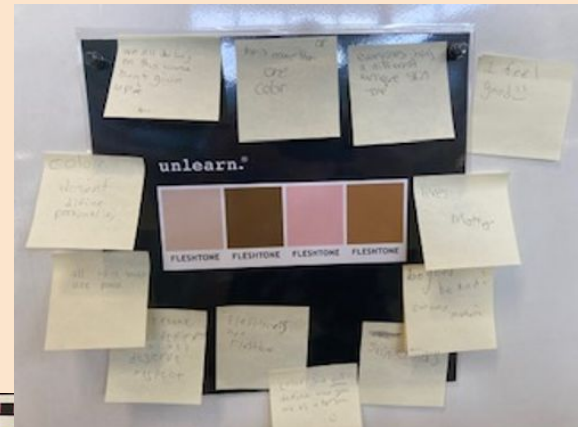

Thank you to everyone who joined chess club this year. It was such a pleasure to be a part of this amazing club!




There will be a quick meeting in Mr. Stormes' room at 10:10 (first recess) for those students who will be representing our school at the chess tournament on Monday.

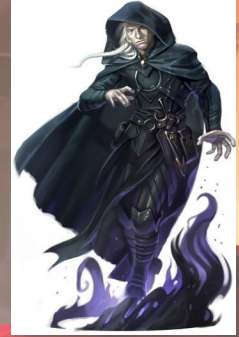

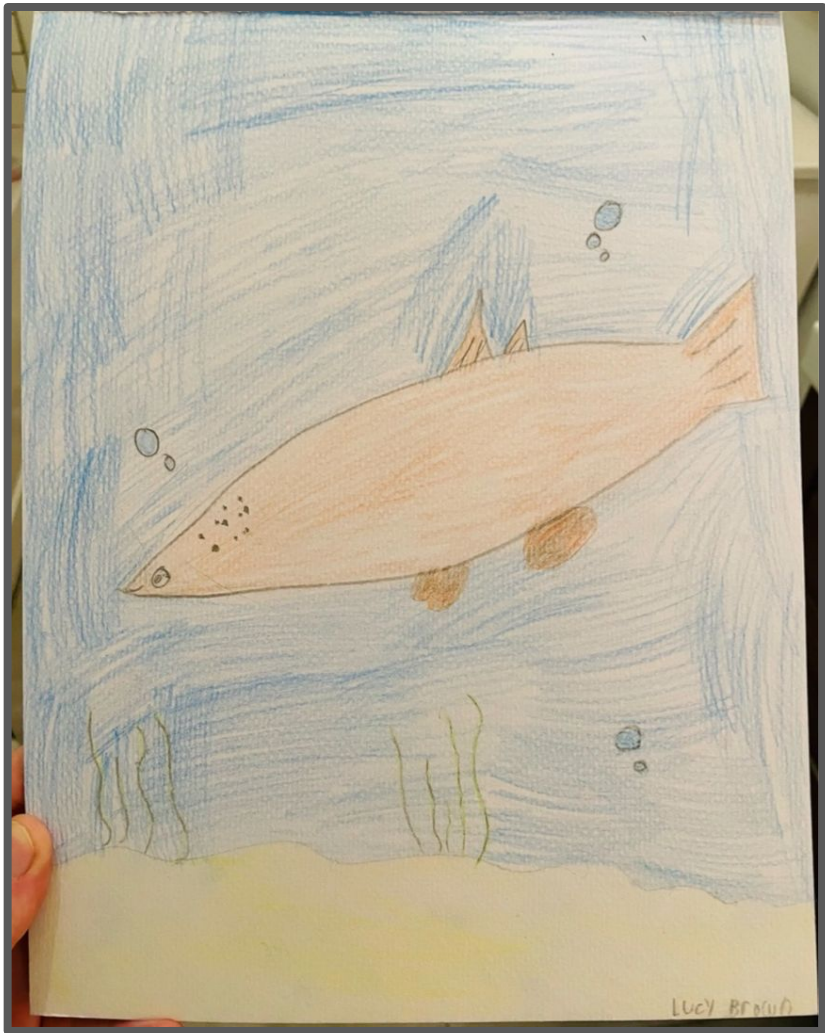

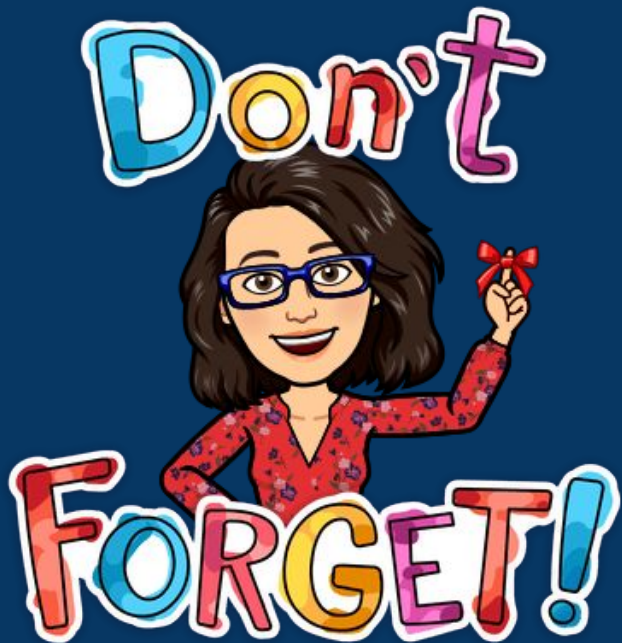

You can be creative with games you play and remember to keep them fair and inclusive.

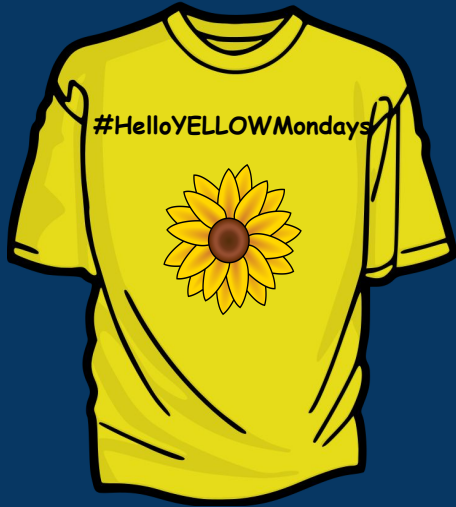
You can play in the snow and have fun building, rolling and running while keeping snow on the ground.
