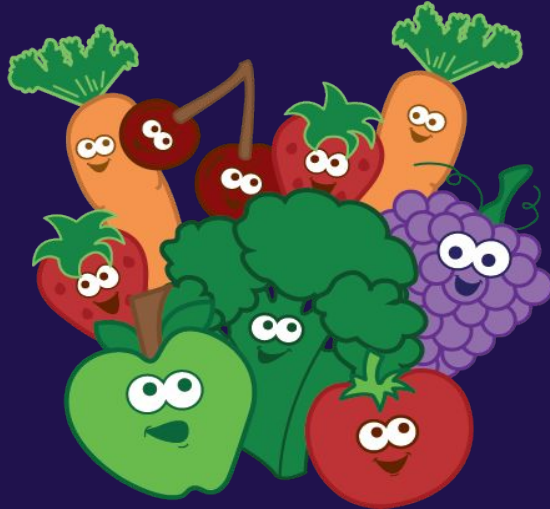
# Let's Talk Math...

Cell phones may only be used for academic tasks **with staff permission.**



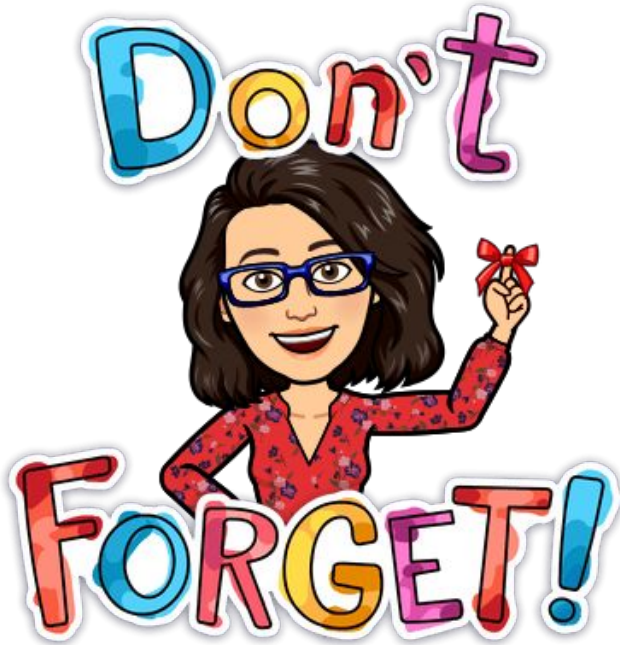


**\*you are to WALK to your bus, not run. Be mindful of those around you.**

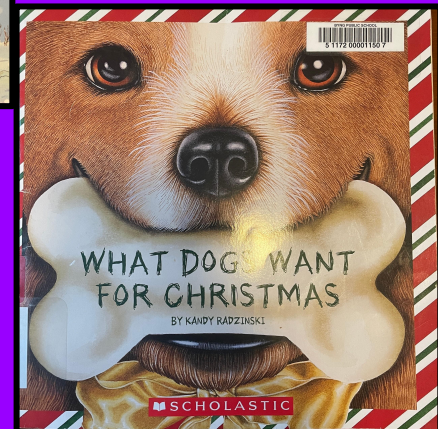
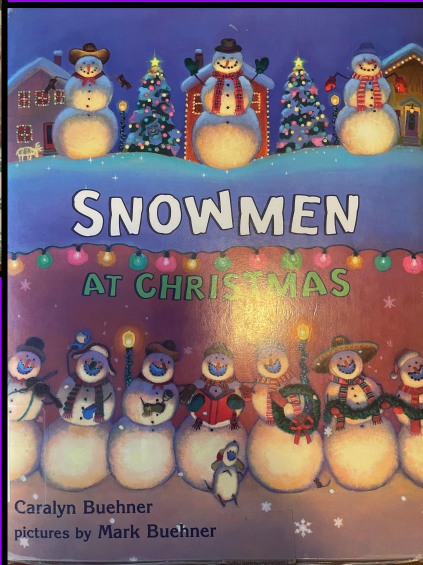
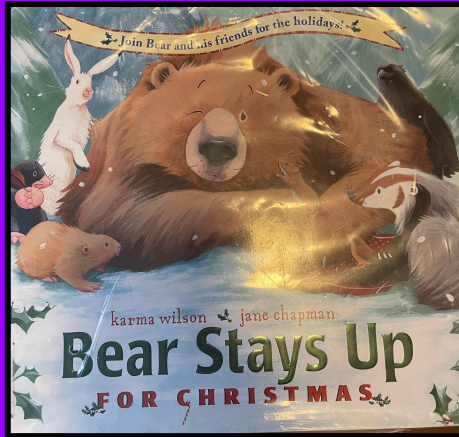
