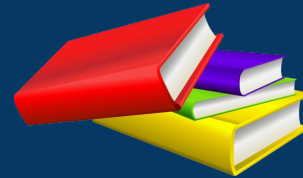
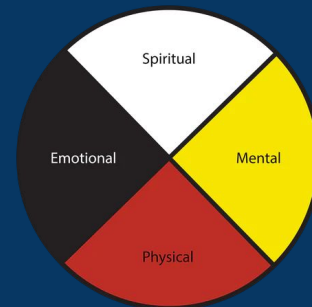

I refuse to participate in the problem.

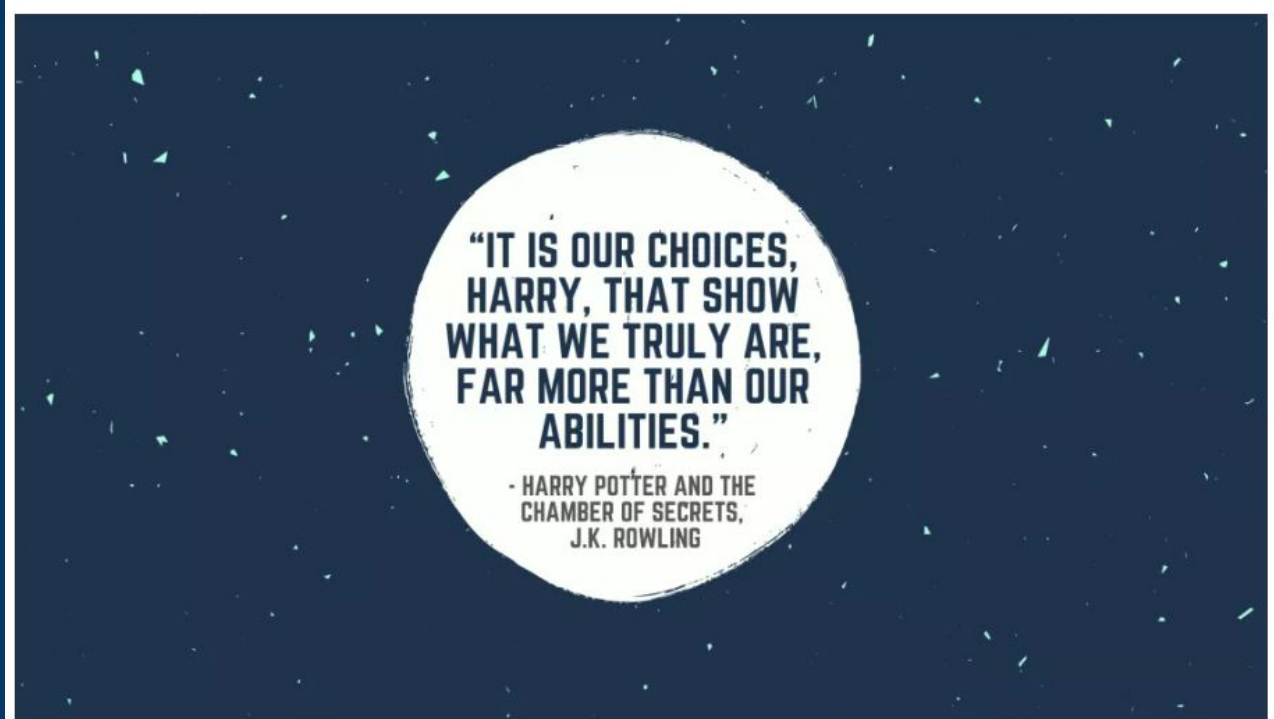
