

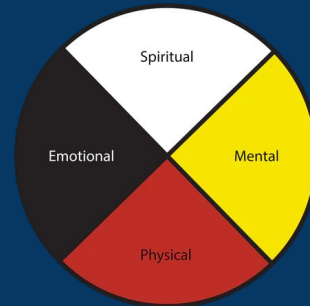

I refuse to participate in the problem.

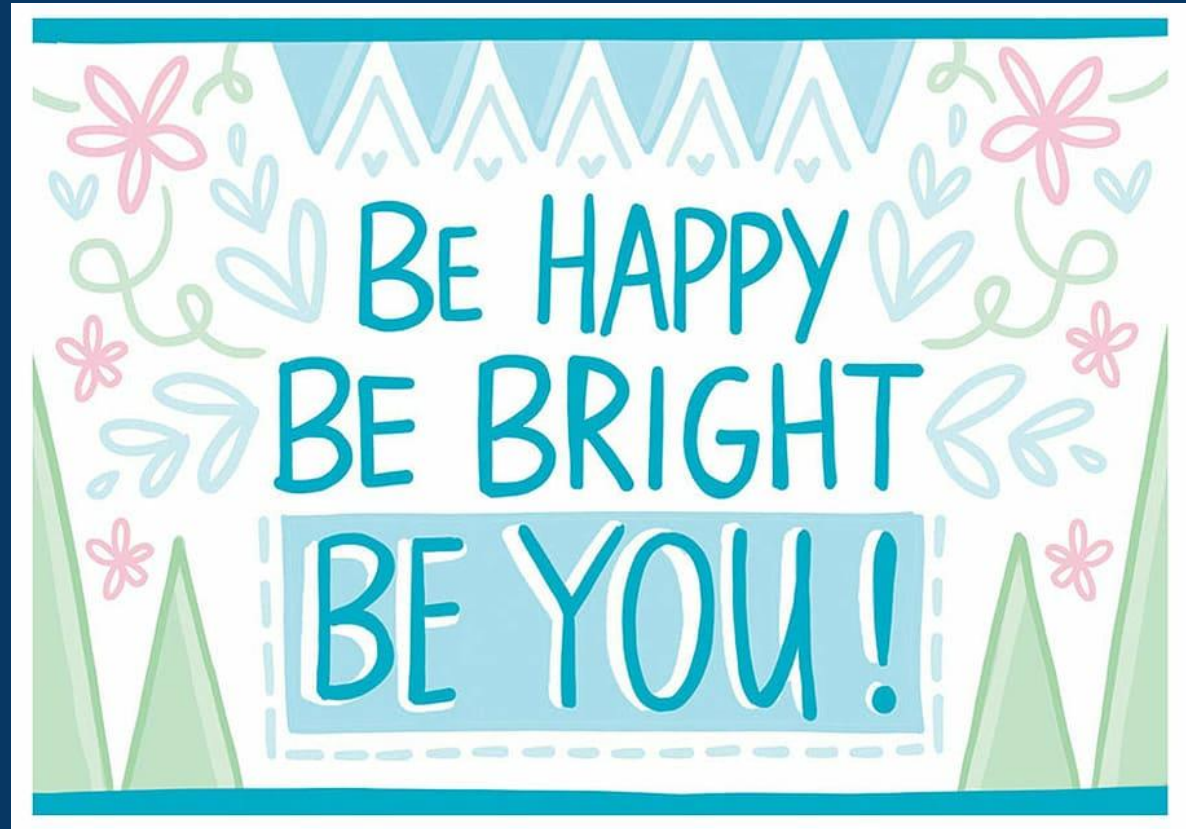

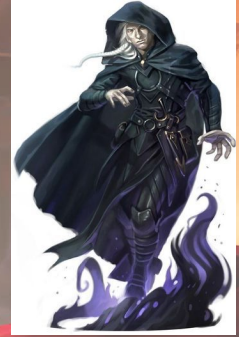

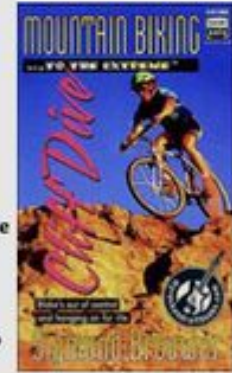


Chute Roll
