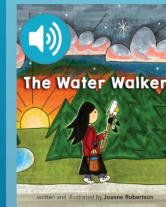
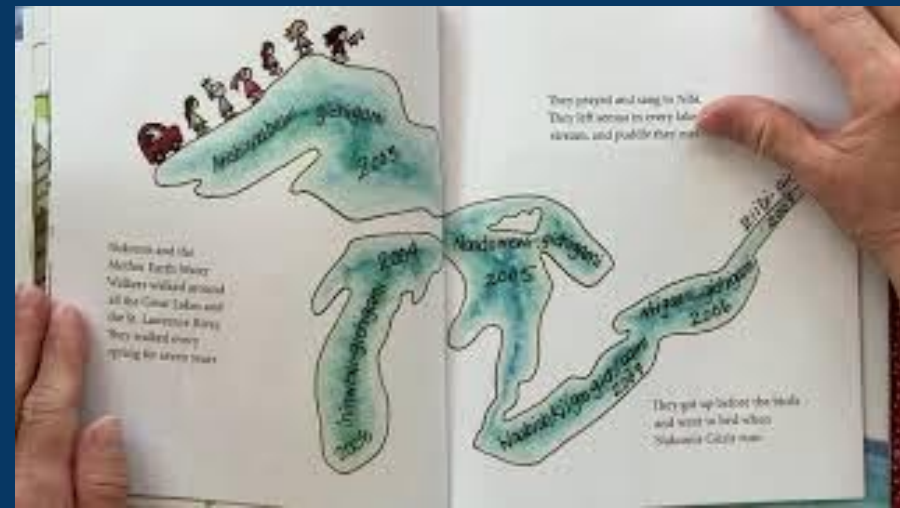
# Literacy Learning

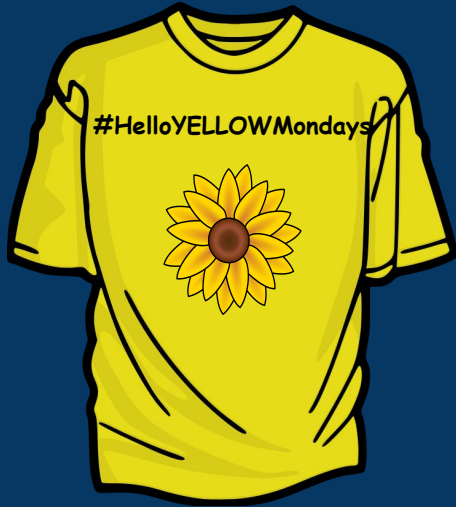

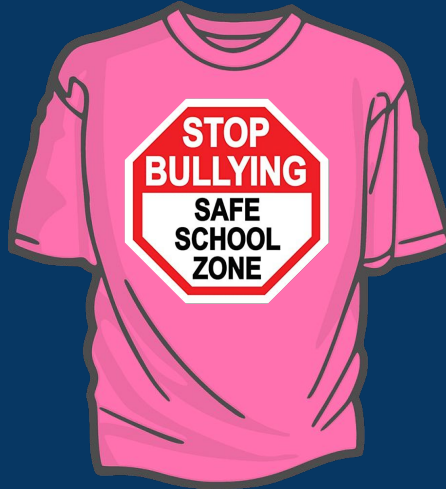
