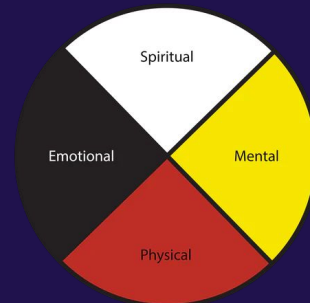

If I think you need help, I'm getting involved.

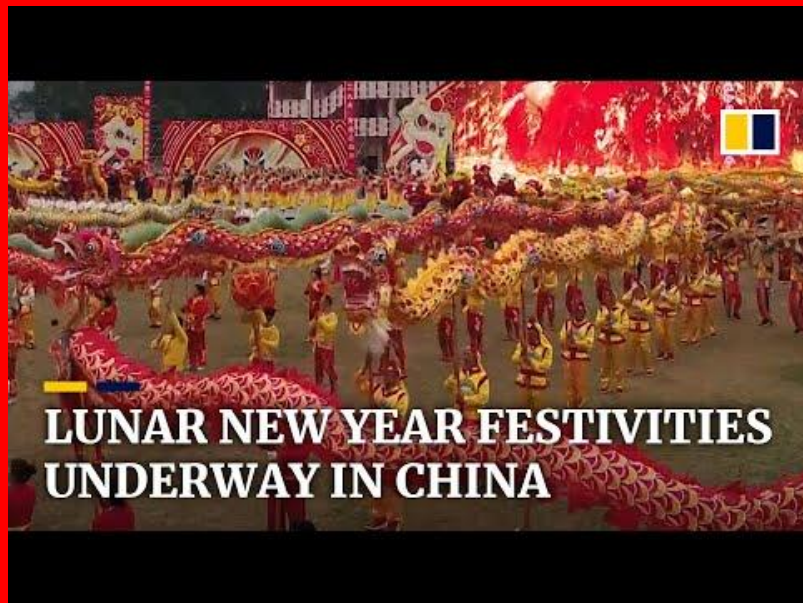

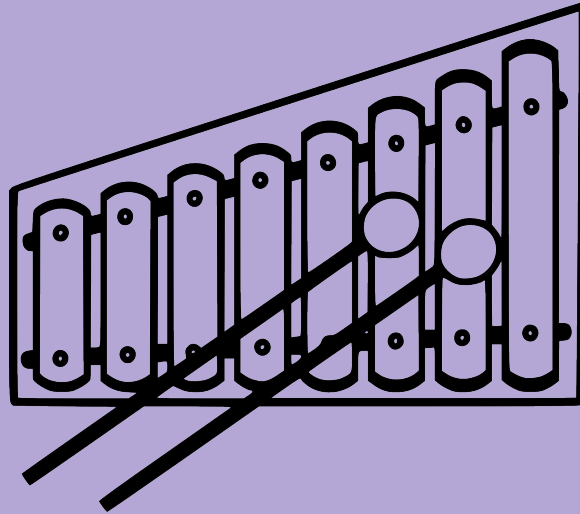


The grade 5 and 6 chess club will meet today at 2nd break (12:30 - 1:10) in the library.
