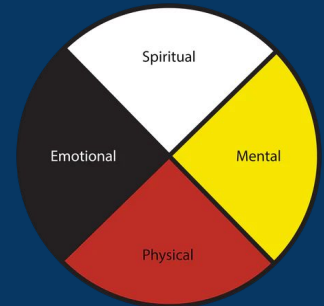

Let's make a couple CMES Wolfpack Playlists!

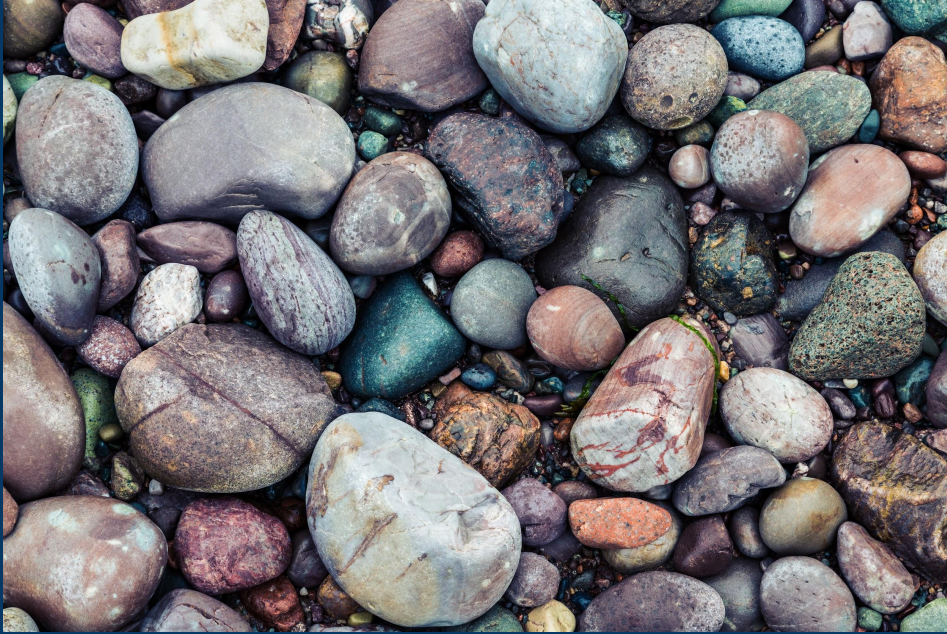

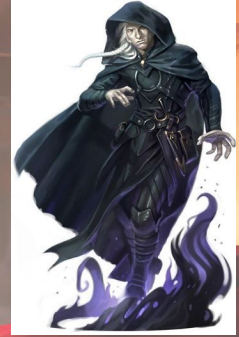

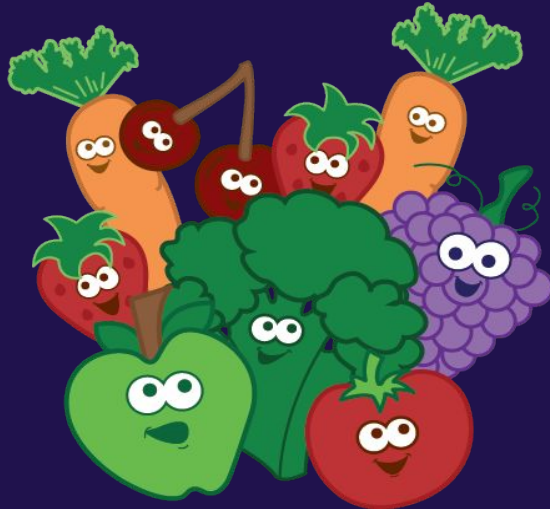
***Bring your buckets down after 2nd break***

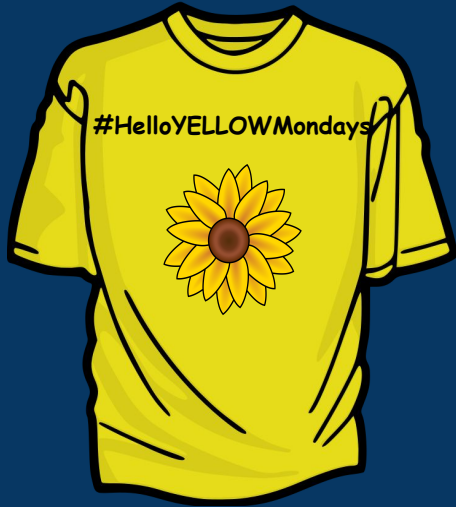
