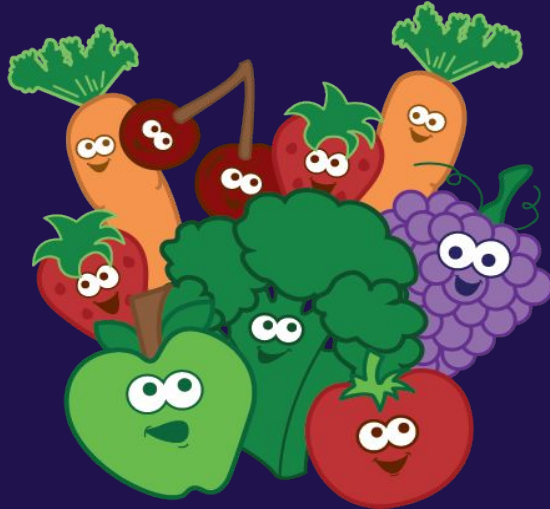


Wear Pink Wednesdays We encourage you all to wear pink on Wednesdays to show that you take a stand against bullying!

Cell phones may only be used for academic tasks **with staff permission.**



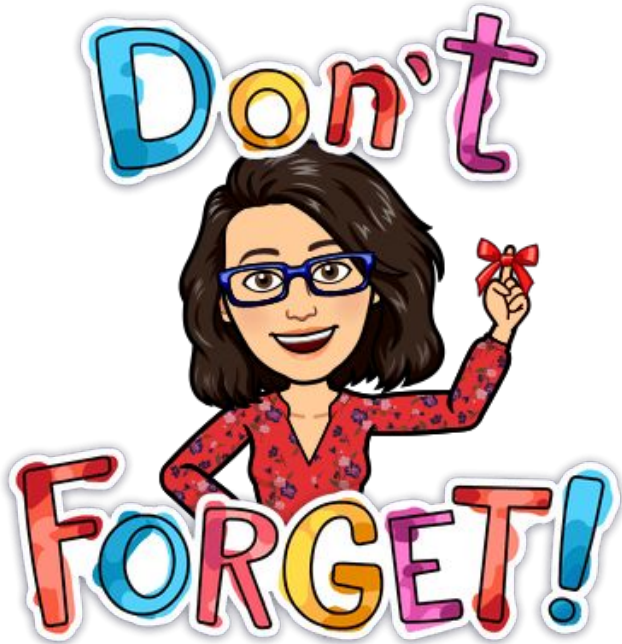




HELP US BOARD AND

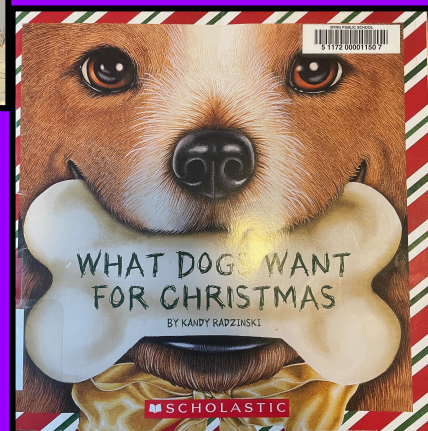
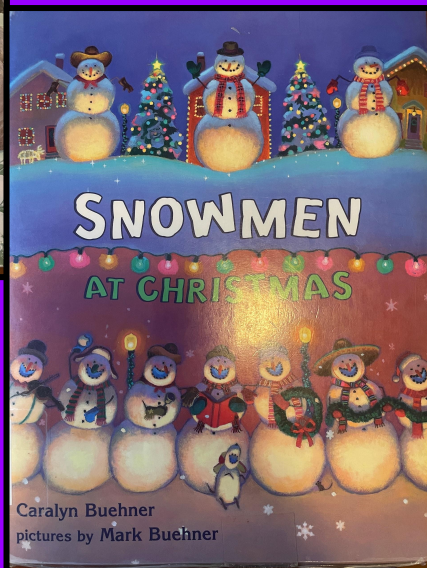
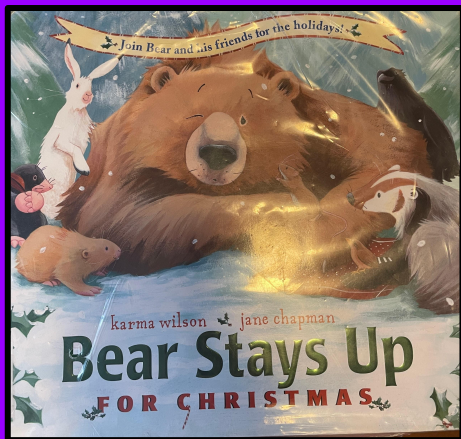
