



As a class, work together to come up with as many words as you can using the letters in the grid. (Letters do not need to touch but you can only use the letter once in a single word).


Write down all of the words your class can spell. Give each word 1 point. If a word has a long vowel sound, give that word 2 points. Total up your points.


The Brown Trout Life Cycle

Alevins


Alevins stay in the gravel, living off the yolk sac. They then emerge as fry, set up territories and grow into parr.

Calls/texts to home must come from the office.






- *you are to WALK to your bus, not run. Be mindful of those around you.

Let's make Clearview THE place to be!





