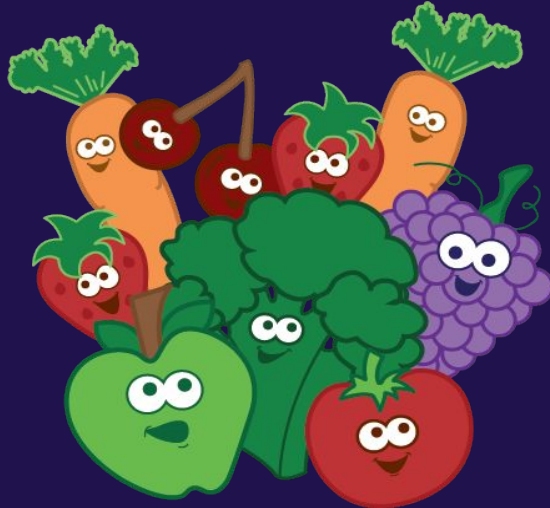
Bring your buckets down after 2nd break

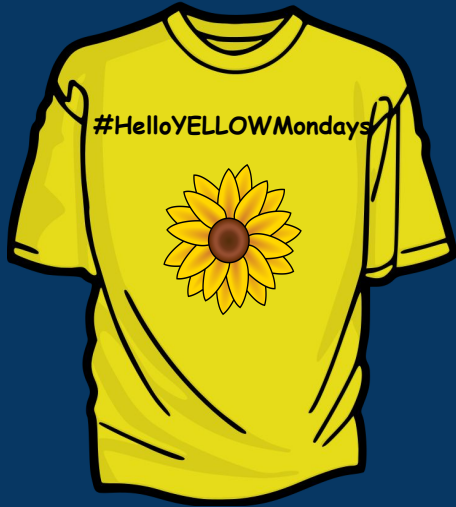
